































Ultrasound-Guided Orthopaedic Injection Techniques & Therapies

Advanced Mare Reproduction

This practical course is aimed at practitioners with a good working knowledge in the field of equine mare reproduction and provides a critical update on the management of mares for artificial insemination, on different causes that lead to mares being barren and how to investigate and treat these problems (incl. hysteroscopy). The 2nd day will focus on the pregnant mare with management of twin pregnancies, foetal sexing, different pregnancy-related problems and peri-partum emergencies (incl. dystocia & retained foetal membranes etc.) The 7 hours of practical / case-based sessions will give attendees plenty of opportunity to put theory into practice on barren-pregnant mares and cadavers in small groups (2-4 attendees per ultrasound machine).





New Developments in Diagnostic & Therapeutic **Techniques of Equine Neck Conditions**

Fri 3 - Sat 4 October

Over the past two decades the equine cervical spine has been extensively researched and advanced imaging modalities like CT and CT-myelography have revolutionized diagnostic and therapeutic capabilities available to equine practitioners. This highly practical course will provide equine practitioners with the knowledge and practical skills to competently examine, diagnose and treat horses affected by neck conditions through the following practical sessions: Neurologic examination (ataxia vs. lameness), CSF tap techniques (incl. 
Joint & Tendon Sheath Ultrasound & Therapies Skills Workshop

Advances in Orthopaedic Therapies

The following orthopaedic therapies will be interactively discussed via an evidence-based approach and the speakers will also explain how they personally use these modalities: Autologous conditioned serum & protein solutions, alcohol-facilitated ankylosis, PrP, acellular amnion, autologous vs. allogeneic stem cell therapy, new OA therapeutics (i.e. polyacrylamide hydrogel), bisphosphonates, Adequan/Cartrophen, nutraceuticals, intra-/extra-articular corticosteroid & hyaluronan, sports horse surgeries etc.. Alcohol-facilitated ankylosis of the distal tarsal joints and ultrasound-guided injections will be trained on equine specimens and simulators as part of the workshops.

Advances in Equine Podiatry Workshop



The hands-on practical and case based sessions will give attendees plenty of opportunity to put theory into practice on live horses and limb specimens in small groups (2 vets per specimen) and to discuss all aspects of foot trimming, shoeing, foot radiography and general farriery under the supervision of two world-renowned experts.


